

# Ric Rac Tea Towels



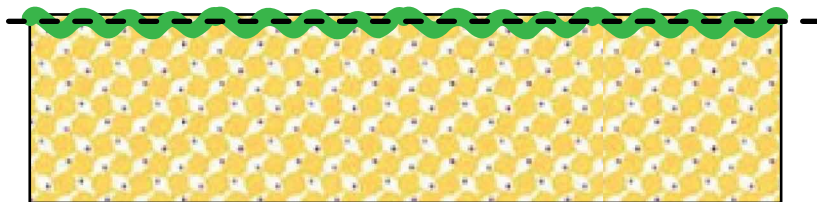

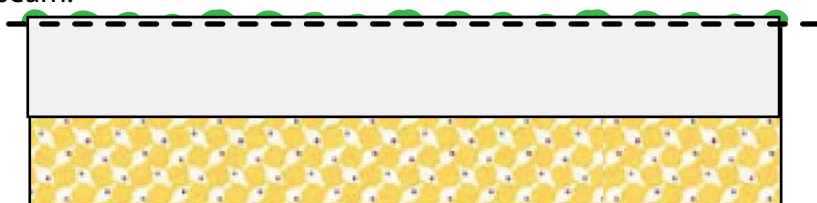
Supplies for 1 towel:

- 1 - 27" x 16" Piece of toweling
- 1 - 2.5" x 18" strip
- 1 - 3" x 18" strip
- 1 - 18" piece of ric rac
- Coordinating thread

Step 1: Take your 3" strip and your piece of ric rac, pin the ric rac onto the top long edge of your 3" strip and sew on -- about a scant 1/4" seam



Step 2: Take your 2.5" strip and lay it on top of your 3.5" strip right sides together, lining up the top edges. Sew a 1/4" seam.



Step 3. Press open.



Step 4: Double fold and hem the top and bottom of your toweling.

Step 5: Place your fabric piece 2.5" from the bottom hem of your toweling. Fold over and press all the edges of your fabric so that it is the width of your toweling. Pin into place and then stitch around to secure.

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
