Read all instructions before starting. All seam allowances are 1/4"

Supplies:

1 Scrappy Flag Kit

Cutting:

Out of red:

30 - 2" x 4 7/8" rectangles (E)

Out of white:

3 - 2" x 18" strips (F)

3 - 2" x 26 3/4" x 26 3/4" (G)

4 - 3.5" x 3.5" squares (B)

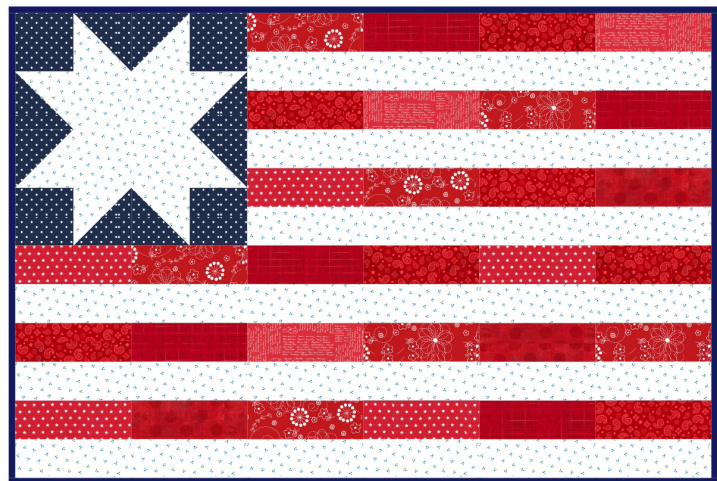
1 - 4 7/8" x 4 7/8" square (D)

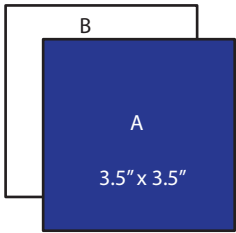
Out of blue:

4 - 3.5" x 3.5" squares (A)

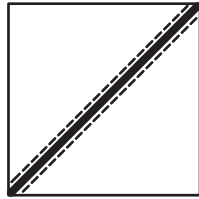
4 - 2 3/4" x 2 3/4" squares (C)

3 - 2.5" x width of fabric strips (for binding)

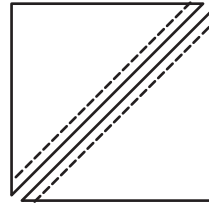




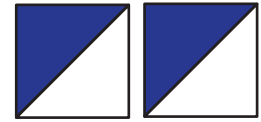
Place an A square and a B square right sides together.



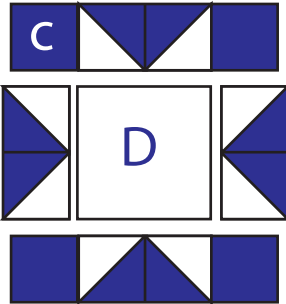
Mark a line from corner to corner. Stitch $\frac{1}{4}$ " from each side of the drawn line.



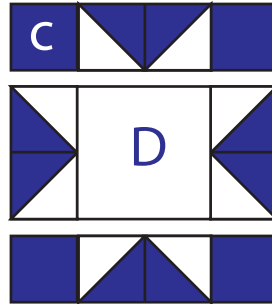
With a rotary cutter and ruler, cut along your marked line.



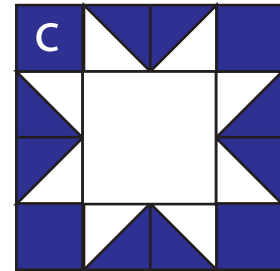
Press your half square triangles to the dark side. Make 8 half square triangles. Trim to $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $2\frac{3}{4}$ "



Sew your half square triangle units in groups of two. On two of the sets, add a C square to the left and right side.



Sew the left and right units on your D square.



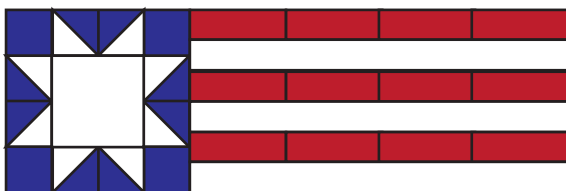
Sew the top and bottom strip on and press. Block should measure 9.25 " x 9.25 "



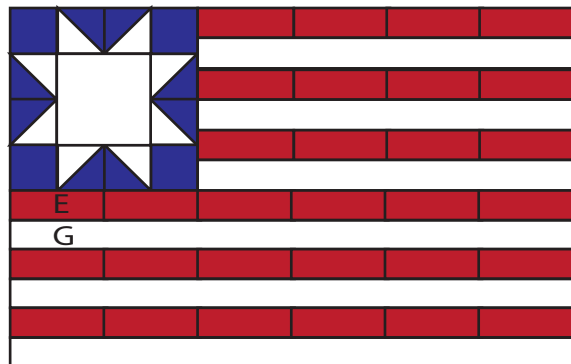
Sew together 4 E rectangles and press. Make three sets. Once you have sewn them together you will add an F strip in between the red strips and one on the bottom. Press.



For the longer strips - Sew together 6 E rectangles - make three sets and then sew a G strip in between the red strips and one on the bottom. Press.



Sew your star block to the left side of your shorter strip set. Press.



Sew your longer strip set to the bottom and press.

Now you are ready to baste, quilt and bind with your preferred method!

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
